



Job Posting for Students Summer Camp Program Assistant Position (4)

Doorsteps Neighbourhood Services is a community development organization focusing on community education, prevention and enhancing resiliency of individuals and communities. Our Mission is to provide accessible resources to the communities we serve through innovative programming and effective partnerships.

Major Responsibilities:

A summer camp program assistant is responsible to take care of a group of 15 to 20 summer camp participants on a daily basis and ensure children's safety, manage children's behavior and act as a role model and mentor. Additionally

- Supervise Campers and ensure their safety and well being
- Facilitate recreational, social, and educational activities for campers, 6-14 years old
- Use group management skills to engage all children in daily activities
- Assist in planning activities that give children the opportunity to express themselves creatively
- Assist with preparing permission slips for outings, book outings and special events/guests for day camp
- Attend planning meetings and training (First Aid and CPR, Resiliency) prior to camp
- Work 30-35 hours per week for 7 weeks (hours will depend on program but could be any time between 9:00AM and 5:00pm)
- Maintain a fun and exciting environment that promotes healthy child development
- Properly maintains a clean work environment
- Able to swim an asset
- Other duties as assigned by Doorsteps Neighbourhood Services

Eligibility Criteria (Applicable to Canada Summer Job Funding) – Applicants MUST:

- Must be between the ages of 15 and 30 years old
- Must have been a full time student during the 2015-16 school year and be returning as a full time student
- Minimum of 1 or more years previous experience in program planning and implementation, working with children aged 6-14
- Must have a previous experience in instruction and programming for children in at least three of the following areas: music (vocal and instrumental) , drama and visual art, sports and cooperative games, computers (educational programs and introduction to the internet), arts and crafts, baking and cooking, environmental awareness
